

Verb Tenses in the Song "Tucson Train" by Bruce Springsteen

Reporter's Question	Springsteen's Answer	Verb tense
1. How often do you play the guitar?	I play the guitar every day.	Simple present
2. What are you doing right now?	I am (or I'm) playing the guitar.	Present progressive
3. What did you do yesterday?	I played the guitar.	Simple past
4. How long have you played the guitar?	I have (or I've) played the guitar for many years.	Present perfect
5. When will you play the guitar in a concert?	I will (or I'll) play the guitar in a concert next week.	Future
