¹ People say "Here's to" when they hold up their drinks to honor someone or something. For example, friends could hold up their drinks and say, "Here's to good friends."

² Correct English is "Here's to the ones that we've got," but in informal spoken English, people sometimes drop the 've. So this line is OK.

³ *Going to* is often pronounced *gonna* in informal spoken English. So *gonna* is OK. But there is another mistake in this line.

⁴ *All right* is the correct spelling, but *alright* is often used in informal writing. So this spelling is OK. (And the spelling *alright* is becoming more common.) But there is another mistake in this line.
